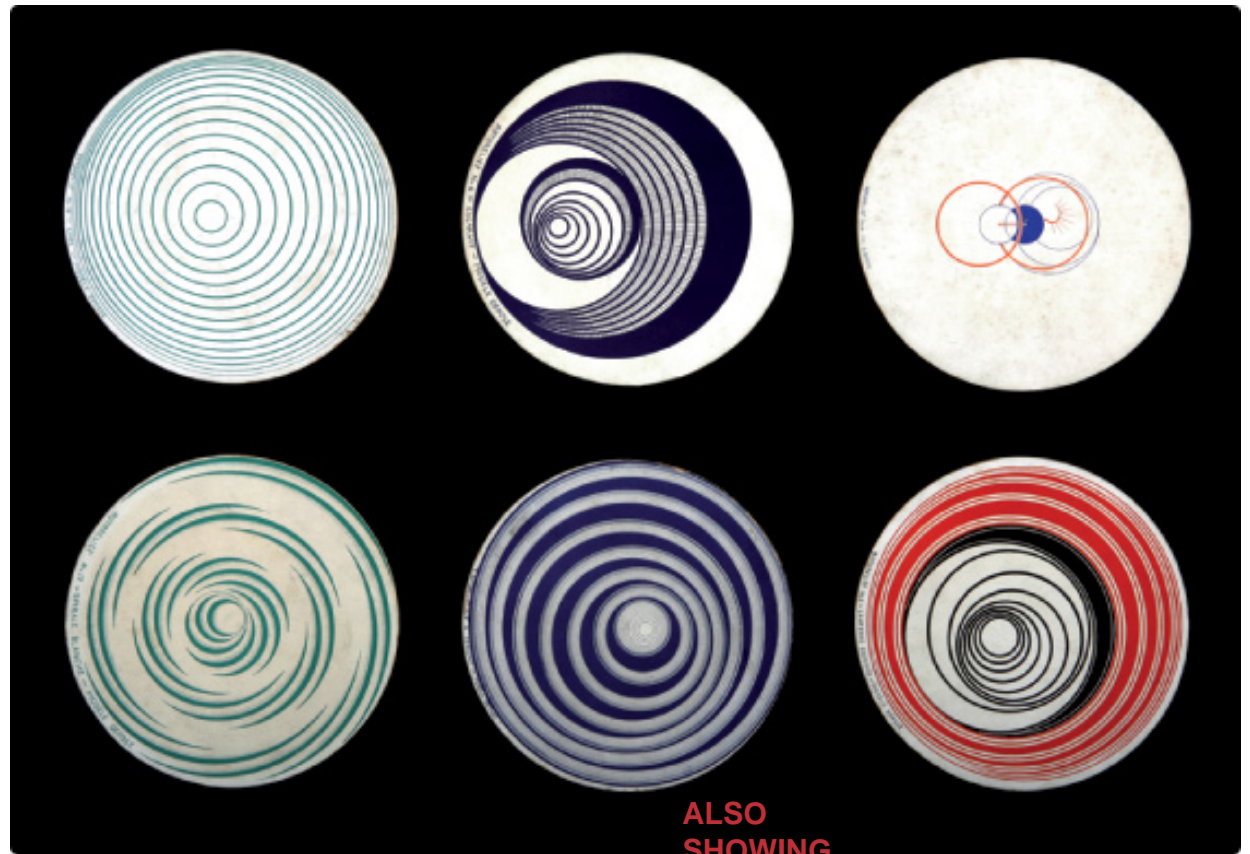
mima's opening exhibition shows drawing by some of the most significant artists of the 20th century in relationship to works by a number of outstanding contemporary artists.

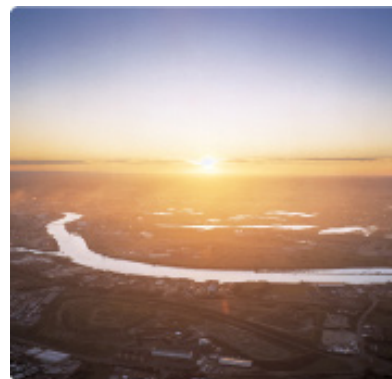


Marcel Duchamp Rotorreliefs, 1935.

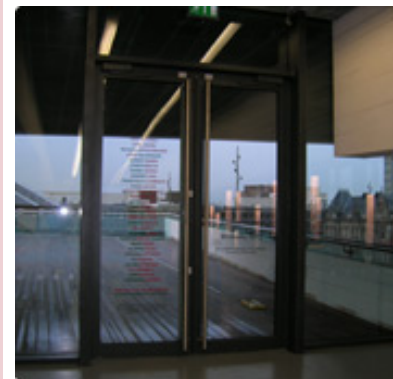

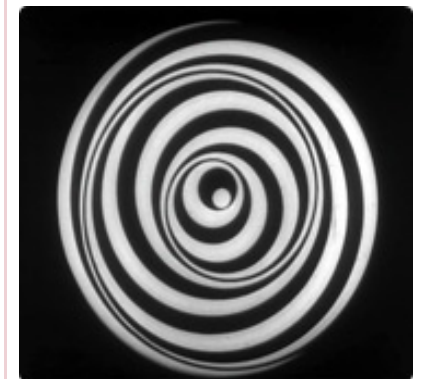
