As a tenant I would have liked to have had a chance to read the job specifications and description and a breakdown of any "expenses" currently being paid to Erimus board members.

I would therefore urge any tenants of Erimus to take up the offer made in the constitution to become "members" merely by paying an extra £1 membership fee.

I pay rent of just under £70 a week so if that entitles me to NO rights to information as a tenant, I will gladly pay an extra £1 if this will give me the right to find out what is happening within the organisation.
